# Seaport at a Glance

| Category             | Data                                  |
|----------------------|---------------------------------------|
| U.S.                 | 9 <sup>th</sup> busiest seaport       |
| West Coast           | 4 <sup>th</sup> busiest seaport       |
| Refrigerated Exports | #1 refrigerated export in the U.S.    |
| Trade                | Near 50/50 balance of imports/exports |
| Marine Facilities    | Four (4) marine terminals             |
| Containers           | 2.25 million TEUs processed in 2025   |
